- ✓ “Small Towns & Big Dreams” produced by Steve Rosen and Brandt, wins CCMA 2002 Album of the Year, Paul also takes home CCMA Male Artist of the Year.
- ✓ June 2003, Brandt begins first studio album project since 1999’s “That’s the Truth”, titled “This Time Around”. Slated for June 29 2004 release. His first single off the CD debuts as the #5 most added song all formats, #4 most added Canadian, and #1 most added at country radio (BDS).
